IMI Opens 21st Manufacturing Site in Serbia

October 2, 2018, Laguna, Philippines — Integrated Micro-Electronics, Inc. (IMI), the 5th largest automotive EMS in the world and a subsidiary of AC Industrial Technology Holdings, Inc. (AC Industrials) recently inaugurated IMI Serbia, its latest manufacturing facility, on September 29, at the City of Niš, Republic of Serbia.

"With IMI, we now open the doors to the future - the 21st century, and we are now part of the global trends," said Serbian president Aleksandar Vučić at the opening of the 14,000-m² factory located at Lozni Kalem in Niska Banja, Niš.

The production facility allows IMI to expand its global footprint and support the growing market for automotive components in the European region.

The factory will boost the manufacturing of electronic car components in the region and further develop the Serbian economy, contributing to the country's competitiveness as an investment location.

"The new manufacturing site will be an extension of IMI Bulgaria and is in anticipation of what we see as a pipeline of contracts," asserted company president Gilles Bernard.
